 - A. AZ Forestry/Fire Marshal Division: No report
 - B. County Fire Resource Group: Jackson reported county engines are in California. He added State Dispatch called and asked to add Seligman to the Mohave County Working Group. Opposed discussion was made from group, T. Martin motioned to not allow Seligman into Mohave County working group, Yeager seconded and motion passed. Jackson stated he would pass the information onto State Dispatch. Jackson added, California has been requesting four personnel on Type III and three personnel on Type VI engines.
 - C. BLM: Browning reported, on behalf of BLM most area fires are almost extinguished. He added BLM will be removing fire restrictions soon following the recent rain events. He asked the group if the county should follow suit. Lastly, local air resources will be migrating north to assist with fires.
 - D. Emergency Management: Browning reported there is an upcoming ICS 400 class in Kingman. He mentioned previously the county had a mass causality plan and the county would like to get fire support for a mass shooter regional causality plan, with feedback between Bullhead, Lake Havasu, Kingman, and Colorado City. Lastly, the Bureau of Reclamation will be conducting a tabletop exercise about the dams.

- E. Legislative: T. Martin reported on PSPRS revised 22/23 costs and how the timing is bad following budget adoptions. He added, departments with Securis also received a revised cost increase, but they are working with the Governor's office on getting the allocated \$13.0 million to help. Lastly, Prop 310 will be on the ballot in November to assist fire districts throughout Arizona. He added, the AZ PFFA will be the face of Prop 310 and will be collecting PAC funding to advertise it. They are asking Chief Officers, County Fire Groups, Vendors, and professional associations to contribute.
